BEGINNING OF NOVITIATE 2023



On 2 February, celebrating the day of Consecrated Life, nine novices from different units of the Marist world began their novitiate in Eden, Davao, Philippines. In the morning, during a celebration of the Word, the novices were reminded that the novitiate time is a journey with Jesus in the style of Mary. They were invited to be always in discernment with Jesus, seeking to listen to his voice and put his word into practice. They were then joined by some confreres from the District of Asia for a festive lunch. In the evening, they celebrated the Eucharist together in unity with all religious in Davao. In the following days, the community started with a retreat on what each Marist is asked to be: a man of prayer, a man of the Church, a man of learning. All of this made the beginning of the novitiate a moment of grace for all.
