INTERNATIONAL APPOINTMENTS

The Superior General has appointed two confreres from the province of Oceania to the Districts of Mexico and South America.



Fr Iosefo Amuri from Fiji has been appointed to the district of Mexico.

Iosefo was ordained in 2022 and is currently ministering in Wairiki Parish on the island of Taveuni. He will attend the Marist Mission Studies workshop in Ranong in September before joining the confreres in Mexico.

Fr Denis Revi from Vanuatu has been appointed to the district of South America.

Denis is a trained formator and currently part of the formation team in Marist College Suva. His appointment starts on 1 May and it is likely that he will minister in the formation house of Belo Horizonte.
