TWO CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS IN EUROPE

Recently in the province of Europe confreres have been celebrating two important 100th anniversaries.



In Dublin, Ireland, the 100th anniversary of the foundation of St Teresa's Church in Donore Avenue was commemorated and thanks was given for all the priests who have served the parish since its opening, especially the Marists who have led the parish since 1980. The festive celebration was presided over by Bishop Paul Dempsey, auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of Dublin, in the presence of many priests, religious and parishioners.

In Pratola Peligna, in Central Italy, the parish

community of the Sanctuary "Maria Santissima della Libera" celebrated 100 years of Marist Presence. A solemn Mass was presided by over by Bishop Michele Fusco, Bishop of Sulmona-Valva and was followed by a feast involving many parishioners and friends. During his homily the bishop emphasized the importance of collaboration between lay people and priests, stating that 'one is necessarily in need of the other's help'.
