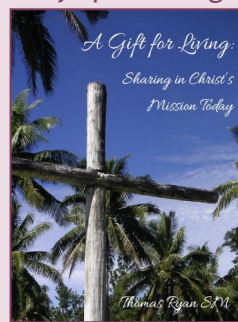

GENERAL ADMINISTRATION

Yesterday was the last day of the General Council Plenary Session. In the past weeks a variety of topics has been covered, among which the approval of chapter statements and decisions from several units and the admission of the candidates for Novitiate 2025. Time was also dedicated to preparations for the General Chapter. On 7 and 8 November the Council had meetings with Br Joe McKee fms, one of the facilitators. Fr Tony Kennedy, the chair of the pre-chapter committee, gave a report on the Survey which was carried out among the membership of the Society in preparation for the Chapter. More than 60 communities worldwide have sent in their responses to the survey. These responses are now being collated in one document, which will be shared in a short time with all confreres.
